19 SEP Skagafjörður – Borgarnes (BD)

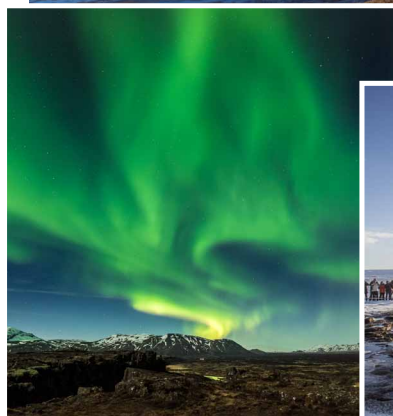
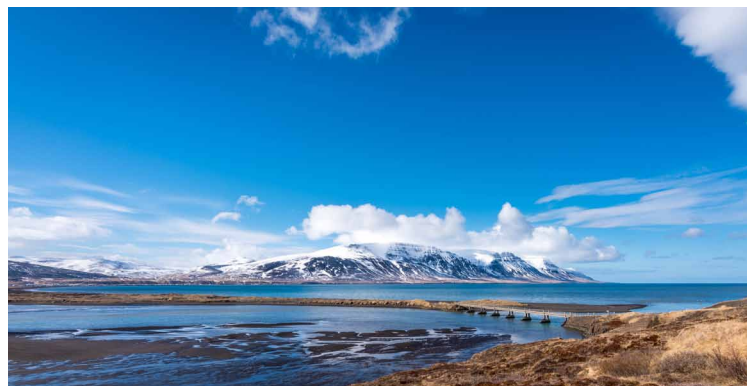
This morning visit Siglufjörður's award-winning Herring-Era Museum. Afterwards, head to historical Skagafjörður to be introduced to the Icelandic horse. Continue through north Iceland towards the village of Blönduós. Cross the moors of Holtavörðuhéiði plateau, and drive through Borgarfjörður to the beautiful town of Borgarnes.

20 SEP Borgarfjörður – Thingvellir – Reykjavík (B)

Travel to Deildartunguhver, the most powerful hot spring in the world. Stop to admire the beautiful Hraunfossar waterfalls before continuing via Hvalfjörður fjord to Lake Thingvallavatn, Iceland's largest lake and Thingvellir National Park, a UNESCO Heritage Site. Carry on to Reykjavík.

21 SEP Departure transfer (B)

Transfer to the airport for your flight home.



12 SEP Depart Toronto

13 SEP Arrival Reykjavík - City Tour (B)

Upon arrival at Reykjavík international airport you will be met and taken to Viking World for breakfast followed by a city tour.

14 SEP Geysir – Gullfoss – Skogar – Dyrhólaey – Vík (BD)

From Reykjavík head through the greenhouse village of Hveragerði. Visit the nearby Fákasel Icelandic Horse Park. Head on to the Golden Circle natural wonders. Explore Gullfoss, the "Golden Waterfall", and the nearby Geysir hot spring area. Continue along the south shore and stop to admire the waterfalls Seljalandsfoss and Skogafoss before continuing to Dyrhólaey nature reserve. Continue to the village of Vík.

15 SEP Vík – Skaftafell National Park – Jökulsárlón Glacial Lagoon – Höfn (BD)

Continue your journey on the Ring Road. Cross Eldhraun, the largest lava flow recorded on the planet. Visit Kirkjubæjarklaustur town. The tour continues over Skeidararsandur sands to Skaftafell, a beautiful glacial area within Vatnajökull National Park. Continue to the stunning Jökulsárlón Glacial Lagoon and onto Höfn.

16 SEP Höfn – East Fjords – Egilsstaðir (BD)

Travel from Höfn through Almannaskard pass. Continue to the towering mountains plunging vertically into the sea that form the magnificent East Fjords. Explore Petra's renowned collection of local stones and minerals.

17 SEP Lake Myvatn Area (BD)

Head towards the Lake Myvatn area. On the way, stop at Dettifoss, Europe's most powerful waterfall. Continue onwards to Namaskard pass with its boiling mud pools and vibrant colours. Explore the natural beauty of the Lake Myvatn area, including the pseudo craters at Skutustadur and the Laxa Salmon River.

18 SEP Lake Myvatn Area – Akureyri – Siglufjörður (B)

Explore the peculiar lava formations at Dimmuborgir. Visit the magnificent Godafoss waterfall before continuing on to Akureyri. Continue along the coastal roads of Eyjafjörður and the Troll Peninsula. This is a beautiful drive along steep mountains with amazing views
